## Why?

I use seperate branches for each learning outcome to keep my work structured and organised. To keep this seperate I can focus on one part of the code at the time. This approach has helped me to keep finished and unfinished code separate and prevented me from keeping mistakes. If something goes wrong in a particular branch, then my main branch remains safe.

### How?

I made separate branches for each learning outcomes, so whenever I update a learning outcomes or the homepage, pushed my code to the corresponding branch.
